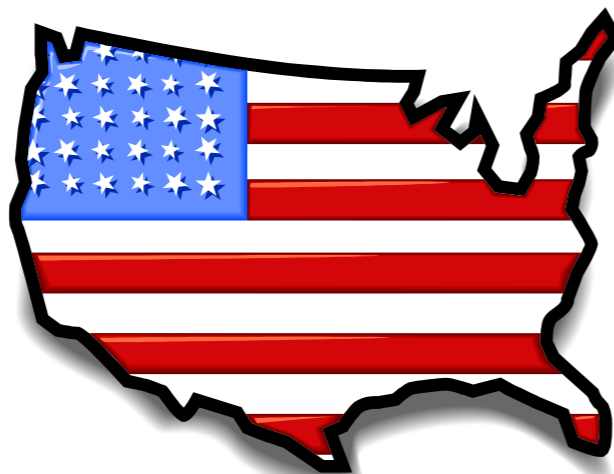

It was another shocker in the news. Another campus shooting, this time on Valentine's Day. And, as always, the stories inside the story were there, including one that wasn't in the news... one that touches your life and mine.

One of the first responders helped carry a wounded student to the ambulance. He rode with her as they rushed to the hospital. This medic happened to be a Christian who had prayed that God would help him **share his Jesus with others**. In that ambulance, he said **he had a chance to tell the student. He didn't**. Shortly after she arrived, she died in the hospital. His heart was broken.

The physical circumstances were extreme, but the spiritual scenario was all too familiar. A Christian with the information heaven depends on. A dying person close to that Christian. And **silence... until it's too late**.

We live in a world of people who are terminal. **Every day, time runs out for 150,000 people in our world.** We don't know how

long they have before they keep their appointment with God, but we do have the News that can impact their eternity. We must tell them while there's time.”
