KIDS' KORNER

We have just finished a busy, but wonderful camp season. It is always exciting to see how God works in the lives of campers and volunteers. But right now I am more excited by the way God is working in the lives of our children.

It all started with a Back-to-School picnic. We all had fun playing with water balloons, fishing, and eating hot dogs & smores. At the end of the night there was a short devotional about serving others. On the way home we were discussing this when Josiah said that he did not want to Hell. He recently memorized John 3:16. God has been putting it in his heart. We began to share The Romans Road with him. "All have sinned..." (Romans 3:23). That the price for sin is death (Romans 6:23). That God's gift to us is eternal life through Jesus death on the cross. And that he needed to confess his sins and pray. He did this. Afterward I asked him how he felt. He said, "Happy and sad. Happy he did it, but sad that he does things wrong." I do not doubt the sincerity of his decision. He is an all or

nothing, black and white kind of person.

As I wrote the date into Josiah's Bible so he would remember his spiritual birthday, Noah said that he did not remember praying salvation's prayer. We went to his Bible where the date was written in. Emily will also hold out her hands to us at the table. We hold hands when we pray and she has been initiating this.
